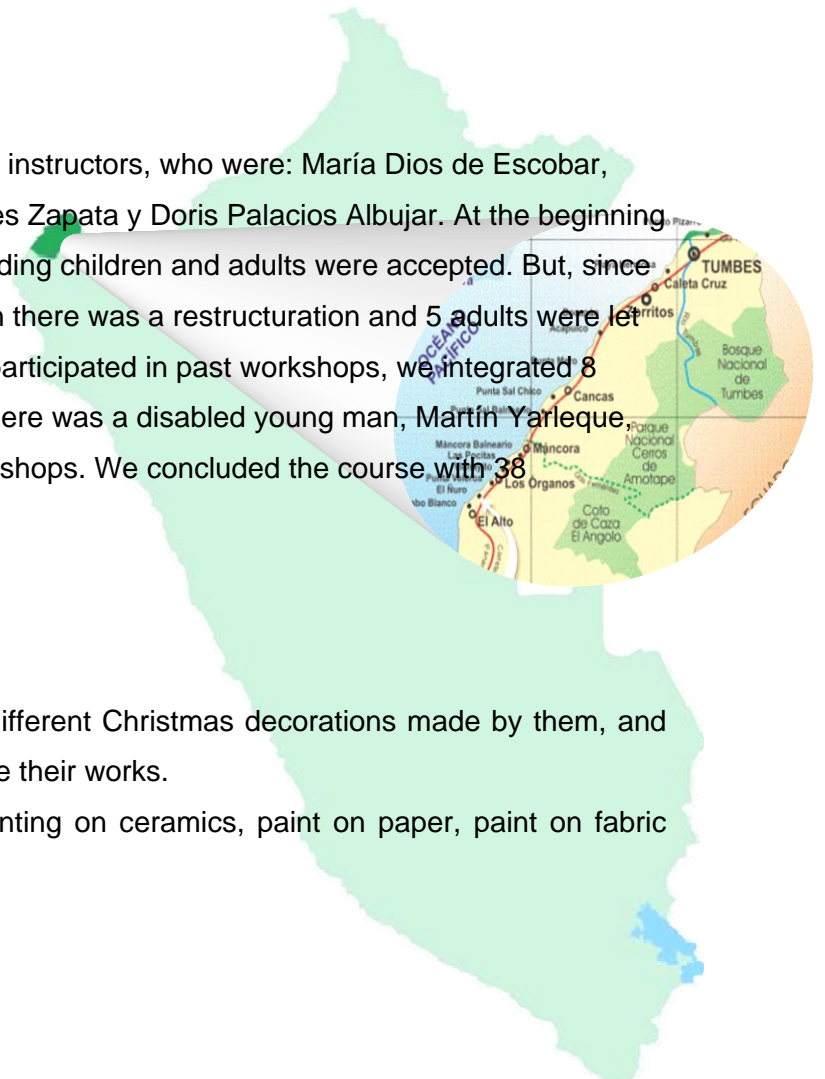

TECHNICAL REPORT

In this workshop we had four instructors, who were: María Dios de Escobar, Yeny Jiménez Álvarez, Leyla Ladines Zapata y Doris Palacios Albuja. At the beginning of the course, about 39 people including children and adults were accepted. But, since many kids wished to participate then there was a restructuring and 5 adults were let go in view of the fact that they had participated in past workshops, we integrated 8 more kids. We must point out that there was a disabled young man, Martín Yarleque, he has participated in all of the workshops. We concluded the course with 38 participants.

OBJECTIVES

- Allow their homes to have different Christmas decorations made by them, and in the future to commercialize their works.
- Learn the techniques of painting on ceramics, paint on paper, paint on fabric and paint on glass.



- Develop the creativity in the participants by realizing everything by hand from our suggested samples.
- Awaken interest in the kids to learn these basic techniques which can be useful for them.

GOALS

- Innovate interest in the alumnae as an alternative to extra economic income in the family.
- Integrate in our association the most talented.

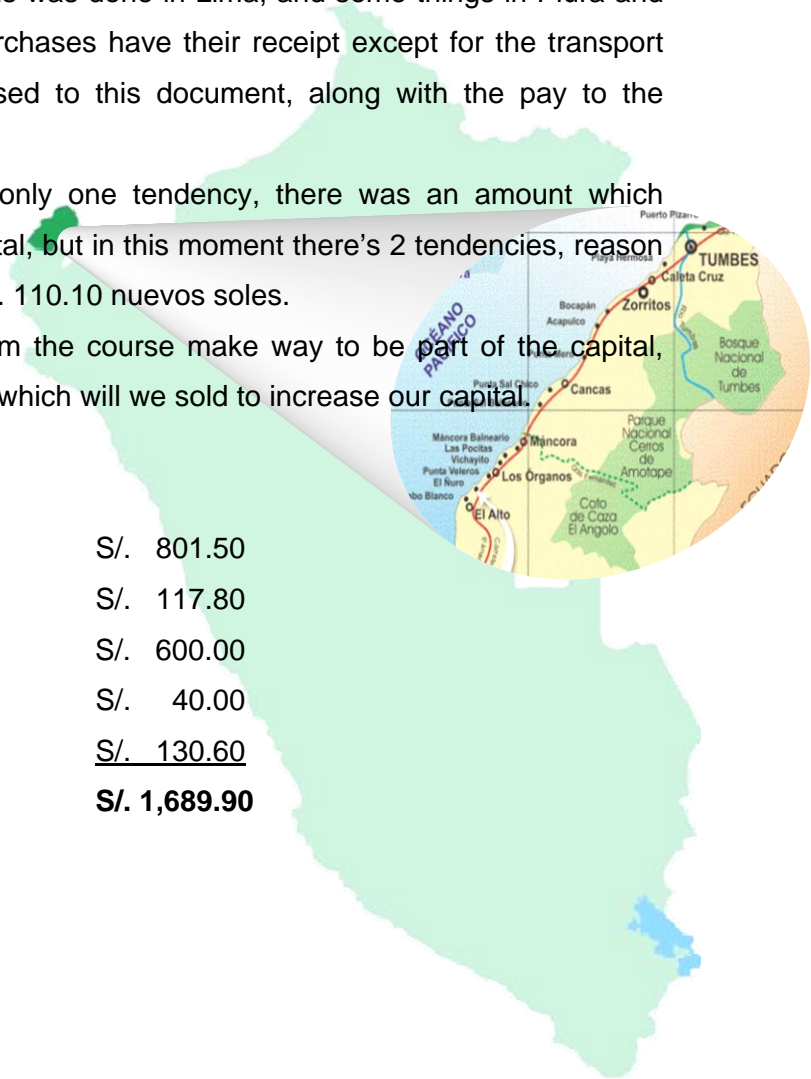
ECONOMIC REPORT

The present document informs the cost of S/. 1800.00 nuevos soles, issued by GOLD OIL, in order to carry out the course “Christmas Handcrafts”, realized in El Ñuro, from the 3rd to the 17th of December 2008.

The purchase of the materials was done in Lima, and some things in Piura and Los Organos. Almost all of the purchases have their receipt except for the transport costs. All of the details are enclosed to this document, along with the pay to the instructors.

When the association had only one tendency, there was an amount which carried on to the cash desk, as capital, but in this moment there’s 2 tendencies, reason for which there will be a return of S/. 110.10 nuevos soles.

Only some materials left from the course make way to be part of the capital, which will serve to realize the crafts which will we sold to increase our capital.

Since the Workshop was developed by four instructors, the designated amount for honorary was divided in 4 equivalent parts according to the amount of hours worked.

CONCLUSIONS

- In this Workshops there's been the presence of 8-year-old children, teenage girls, and moms.
- After evaluating the participants we can say that many of them have the potential to create art and handicrafts in el Ñuro, like a legacy from GOLD OIL and Sr. Thomas Tidow.
- Many of the participants are already making production to sell in their locality, they have some difficulties buying the materials, which will be solved by our association, by providing according to their necessities.
- With the development of this Workshop, we have capacitated a total of 118 people, for those in 2009; we will carry out some for the second phase.
- At the beginning of the first Workshops, the spouses of our participants weren't all happy with us, but after seeing the results they congratulated us for the initiative and gave big gratitude to the company Gold Oil. They also solicited that we carry on with these courses.

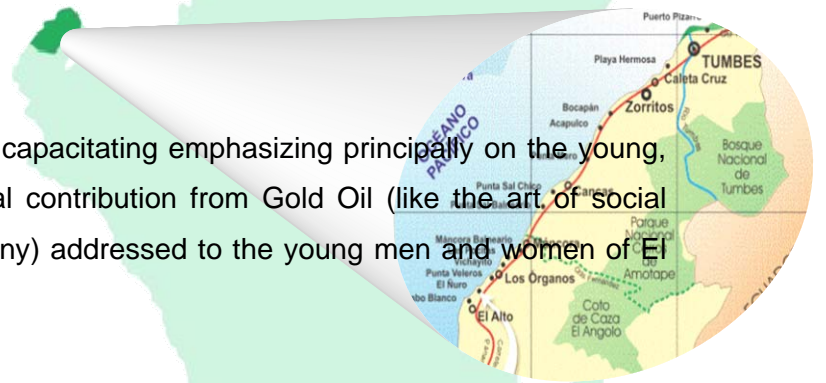
RECOMMENDATIONS
